

The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was 7.4%, which is above South Carolina's baseline (3.6%). The ILI activity level overall was high.

This week 7 influenza-associated deaths were reported. The cumulative mortality rate is 1.0 per 100,000. In the current flu season, there have been 51 influenza-associated deaths.

Smart-911

A web based database that allows citizens to preload vital information into a secure database. When the citizen then dials 911, the database automatically provides the 911 operator with the information the caller has preloaded. This can include information from pictures of the home to medicines the caller and/or victim is taking. This information is only available to the dispatcher during the time of the call. Success stories around the country include missing Alzheimer's patients where a picture was included in the Smart 911 database. The 911 operator was immediately provided the responders with a current picture of the victim which results in a quick location of the victim. Sign up is free, voluntary and customizable by the caller.
